

RESOLUTION NUMBER 7839

WHEREAS, the Beatrice City Code requires any person desiring to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon the public street, public parking lots, or public property must first obtain permission from the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, Denise Pahl, d/b/a Tall Tree Tastings, has requested permission from the Mayor and City Council to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon City Property; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Beatrice, Nebraska, have reviewed said request and desire to grant Denise Pahl, d/b/a Tall Tree Tastings, and designees, permission to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon the right-of-way immediately adjacent to the building located at 122 North 5th Street, Beatrice, Nebraska, effective immediately through December 31, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Council of Beatrice, Nebraska hereby grant Denise Pahl, d/b/a Tall Tree Tastings, and designees, permission to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon the right-of-way immediately adjacent to the building located at 122 North 5th Street, Beatrice, Nebraska. Said permission should be effective immediately and terminate December 31, 2026.

SECTION 2. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
