WHEREAS, the Beatrice City Code requires any person desiring to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon the public street, public parking lots, or public property to first obtain permission from the Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, Midwest Music Productions has requested permission from the Mayor and City Council to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon the City Property located at the Tabernacle in Chautauqua Park on September 26, 2026, between 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., as part of their Punk at the Park Revival event; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Beatrice, Nebraska, have reviewed said request and desire to grant Midwest Music Productions, and their designees, permission to sell or offer for sale or peddle good, wares, or merchandise upon the City Property located at the Tabernacle in Chautauqua Park on September 26, 2026, between 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., as part of their Punk at the Park Revival event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Council of Beatrice, Nebraska hereby grants permission to the Midwest Music Productions, and their designees, to sell or offer for sale or peddle goods, wares, or merchandise upon the City Property located at the Tabernacle in Chautauqua Park. Said permission should be effective on September 26, 2026, between 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
