Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Hastings, Minnesota will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 PM, Monday, October 19, 2026 in the City Council Chambers of Hastings City Hall, 101 East 4th Street - Hastings, MN. The public hearing will be held to solicit public comment on the changes to access and right-of-way proposed in the layout plan for the Reconstruction of Highway 61 from 3rd Street to 36th Street, State Project 1913-107. The City Council meeting may also be accessed virtually using a platform called Microsoft Teams. There you will find a link to join the Public Meeting via Teams. The City Council will receive public comments on the proposed project. Such persons who desire to be heard with reference to the proposed improvements will be heard in person or virtually at such time and place.
