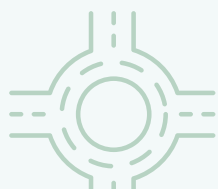

Improving safety, reducing number of crashes and severity of injuries, and keeping traffic moving efficiently.



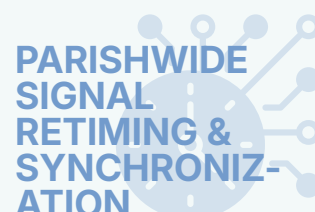
SIGNALING/TURN LANES

Every project in this package was selected with a purpose: to solve real transportation challenges, improve daily commutes, and prepare Lafayette Parish for the growth that's happening.

CAPITAL OUTLAY

The **bond renewal does not fund this vision alone**. Delivering Commuter Connections will require a combination of local, state, and federal resources. Lafayette Consolidated Government (LCG) will continue working with state and regional partners to identify opportunities through this effort and others to further reduce congestion across Lafayette Parish.



CONTINUED INVESTMENT. ZERO NEW BURDEN.

This proposal renews an existing bond millage (**not a new tax**) to improve the commuter corridors people rely on every day.
