Hello Lehi!

September is upon us, and with it the changing of the seasons. As we embark upon a new time of year, I invite you to reflect on your current season of life and what serves you.

As a nurse, I have seen that for some, September marks a time when mental health needs increase. School routines bring stability, but also stress. With shorter, colder days ahead, feelings of isolation can creep in, as well as anxiety and overwhelm. This contributes to the epidemic of loneliness—considered as dangerous to heart health as smoking. So, what is the remedy?

I posit to you that one answer is service. Service reconnects us to each other. Studies show that serving not only benefits the recipient, but volunteering reduces stress, combats depression, and increases long-term well-being. Carnegie Mellon University found that older adults who regularly volunteer reduce their risk of high blood pressure by 40%. Harvard researchers found that people who volunteer experience a measurable boost in mood and life satisfaction. The National Institute on Aging notes that volunteering fosters a sense of belonging and identity.

September 12th marks Lehi's 5th Annual Day of Service with opportunities to contribute throughout the city. However, service isn't limited to one day. I invite us to use September as a springboard to serve our community throughout the year.

As I meet more of the wonderful people of Lehi every day, I have become increasingly aware of both the challenges facing our residents and the incredible goodness and opportunities that we have here. My father taught me, where there is great opportunity, there is great responsibility. I invite you to contribute to the greatness of Lehi through lifting those around you, whatever that looks like for you. And in the process, you may just lift yourself.

Serving others doesn't just heal communities—it heals hearts.

Literacy Center

This month we begin our Fall After-School Reading & Math Session on September 9 and 10 at both of our centers. This session runs through November 12.

Our Fall ABC Session began last month and will continue until December 17. After-School programs offer reading and math classes for Lehi students in K - 4th grade. Classes are 45 minutes twice a week

Monday/Wednesday OR Tuesday/Thursday. Class times are 4 p.m. and 5 p.m. (Main Center) and 3 p.m. and 4 p.m. (Satellite Center).
