08/16 2800 block of Jolly Road for a larceny. The victim states they left their bicycle on the sidewalk and did not lock it on anything. When they returned, the bicycle was stolen. The victim did not know the serial number and no suspect was identified. Report is on file.

08/17 On the 4800 block of Marsh Road for a retail fraud. The loss prevention employee stated they saw two individuals, who are related and wanted in connection with other retail frauds around the lower peninsula, enter the store and take merchandise. They passed both points of sale without purchasing the items. Approximate value of items is \$2300. Awaiting photo lineup.

08/18 2900 block of Hannah Blvd for a larceny from an automobile. The victim states they were distracted when parking their vehicle and did not lock their vehicle. After going inside the establishment, they began getting fraud notifications from credit card companies on their cell phone. The subject had stolen the victim's wallet and attempted to use the cards at different locations. Approximate value of items taken from the vehicle is \$1850. A subject has been identified. Prosecution is being sought.

08/19 4500 block of Donerail Place for a fraud incident. The caller states they received a phone call from an individual saying they were a Sergeant with the US District Court and that the victim had missed jury duty and would be placed under arrest if they did not

Venmo the subject \$1500. The victim sent the money and then called local authorities who had informed them that it was a scam. No subject has been identified. Report is on file.

08/21 1900 block of W. Grand River for a counterfeit report. An employee of the establishment found a counterfeit bill when counting down the till for the night. They have no way of knowing who would've given them the counterfeit \$20.00. Lack of investigative leads. Report is on file.

08/22 2000 block of W. Grand River for a suspicious situation. An employee of the establishment called to report that there were random notes left under their windshield wipers when they returned to their car from finishing their work shift. They do not know who could have placed them there. The notes were not threatening by nature. Report is on file.

08/23 2200 Hampton Place for a trespassing report. The caller states there was an unconscious individual in the stairwell. Once police arrived, it was determined the individual was asleep. The subject has been trespassed for life from the establishment.

08/24 4800 block of Marsh Road for a retail fraud. Two subjects entered the establishment and began taking items off the shelves. They had passed all points of sale and exited the building. Approximate value of items stolen is \$2360. No subjects have been identified.

After observing them with a Nike Tech sweatshirt walking towards the exit, the manager attempted to intervene but was unsuccessful. Approximate value of the sweatshirt is \$140.00. Report is on file. Lack of investigative leads.

08/30 2000 block of W. Grand River for a fraud report. The manager of the establishment called the police when a customer was attempting to open a credit card with a fake ID. Once the customer was confronted by police, they admitted they knew it was wrong. The subject was found with multiple fake IDs. Subject was arrested. Police procedures completed.

The victim says they locked their vehicle overnight and when they went to their car the next morning, their trunk had been open and everything inside of it had been stolen.
