Meridian Township Tax Bill Summary

The calculations below are based on the 2026 median *taxable value (TV)* of properties in Meridian Township of \$126,281 and 2025 millage rates. The median *state equalized value (SEV)*, or 50% of a property's market value, is \$165,900.

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State Education Tax (SET)

SET Explained: The State Education Tax (SET) is a part of the 1994 Proposal A, which changed the way that K-12 education is funded in Michigan. The State levies the 6 mills state education tax statewide on all real and tangible personal property. The State adds those funds to other revenue of the School Aid Fund and redistributes the funds back to the local districts.

Ingham Intermediate School District

This Ingham County Intermediate School District (IISD) offers hundreds of career programs and services, such as medical training, plumbing, electrical and construction trades, and cosmetology that promote cost savings among local schools including the four school districts serving Meridian Township families. The IISD also provides a network of support for preschoolers, families, students with special needs and individual interests, and educators.

Administration Fee

The General Property Tax Act stipulates that the property tax administration fee is to be used to offset costs incurred by a collecting unit in assessing property values, in collecting the property tax levies, and in the review and appeals processes. If the bond of the treasurer, as required by the Act, is furnished by a surety company, the cost of the bond may be paid from the property tax administration fee.
