1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Armbruster called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

3A. CHAIRMAN REMARKS

Chair Armbruster shared with the committee the following updates:

- The June meeting minutes will be reviewed during next month's meeting.
- This year's "Landing Blitz" took place on July 11. There were 2 DNR officers, and Eric Bacon from EGLE stopped by. The volunteers engaged a total of 26 boaters (17 going in & 9 leaving).
- The wake-boat sign is now installed at the boat launch.
- Curt mentioned that he's working with the Township communications department on updating & uploading the resources list to the new Township's web site.
- The lake water level was checked recently, and it was about 1.2" lower than the top of the board.

3B. PROJECT UPDATES

- The lake consultant conducted another lake survey yesterday and reported that the lake looked good. He'll be back in August for another survey, which will likely determine if harvesting will be needed.

3C. WEED DISPOSAL FROM PRIVATE SHORES

The committee briefly discussed recent inquiries from shoreline property owners about using SAD funds to dispose of collected dead weed from their private shores. The consensus of the committee was to refer this issue to the LLPOA.

3D. LLPOA DAM UPDATE

Chair Armbruster reported that a construction trailer was observed near the work area. However, there were no other indications that work was imminent. He also noted that a large evergreen Tree was still laying over the north side of the outfall.

3E. PARK MANAGER REPORT

- A new power-washer is being ordered for the boat launch. The committee voted unanimously to pay 50% of its cost.
- The county park north project started two weeks ago. It includes the replacements of 5 boardwalks. The boardwalks will be wider and built on helical piles.
- A pre-construction meeting for the County Park South is scheduled for tomorrow. It will include work on the HBA area at the corner of Lake Lansing and Marsh Road. It will also include relocation of the sidewalk farther away from the shoreline.
