08/01 On the 2000 block of W. Grand River Avenue for a retail fraud. The caller states that an individual wearing a face mask walked in and grabbed a PlayStation 5, then proceeded to walk past all points of sale and exited the store. Approximate value of item is \$899.99. No suspect has been identified. Report is on file.

08/02 4800 block of Marsh Road for trespassing. An individual was in the restroom acting aggressive and refusing to leave once asked to do so. The subject was identified and has been trespassed from that property for life.

08/03 2900 block of Hannah Drive for a larceny report. The caller stated that they saw a truck with two individuals get out and cut a cable connecting a utility trailer to a parking structure. The subjects were on camera, but they have yet to be identified. Approximate value of the trailer is \$1500. Report is on file.

08/04 Report came into the lobby regarding illegal use of a credit card. The victim states they attempted to buy razors online but felt the website to be a scam once they had finished making the purchase. Approximate total of fraudulent transactions is \$927.98. No suspect has been identified. Report is on file.

08/05 A report came into the lobby for ID fraud. The caller states that they were contacted by an individual from AT&T stating their number had been fraudulently linked to other accounts. The caller has not noticed any suspicious activity in their bank account but wanted to report it. Report is on file.

08/07 2000 block of W. Grand River for a retail fraud. The caller states they saw the subject take items from the shelves and exit the building without purchasing them. The subject was located and arrested on a warrant separate from retail fraud. Prosecution for retail fraud is being sought.

08/08 4800 block of Marsh Road for retail fraud. The caller says they watched an individual walk into the store who had previously stolen merchandise. The loss-prevention manager then witnessed the subject take items and pass all points of sale. The subject was met outside by staff and handed the merchandise back to the employees. The subject has been trespassed from the establishment for one year.

08/09 2800 block of E. Grand River for trespassing. The caller stated that an individual was outside harassing people in front of their business. The subject has been trespassed for one year. Police procedures completed.

08/10 2300 block of E. Lake Lansing Road for a fraud report. The victim states they listed an item on Facebook marketplace when a potential buyer said they sent money through Venmo and asked the victim to share their screen with the subject. The subject then stole the victim's information and sent themselves \$2,000. No suspect has been identified. Report is on file.

08/11 2000 block of E. Saginaw Hwy for a larceny of checks report. The reporting party and business owner stated that checks were stolen out of their mailbox, and an unknown subject attempted to cash them. The subject was unsuccessful. Report is on file.

08/12 4800 block of Marsh Road for a retail fraud. The subject presented a fake Instacart receipt to the employee at the service desk claiming it was a real receipt for a Playstation 5 and a Meta Quest 3. The employee believed it to be real and let the subject leave with the merchandise. The subject has been identified and has taken part in multiple retail frauds around the country. Prosecution is being sought.

08/13 2900 block of Northwind Drive for a larceny from automobile report. The victim states they left their vehicle unlocked and unattended. When they returned a couple of hours later, they noticed items missing from the vehicle. The victim does not wish to pursue charges. No suspect has been identified.

08/14 2400 Burcham Drive for a suspicious situation. The victim states they had a handyman at their house working on repairs and said they could hear them talking to someone on the phone about the door in a manner that sounded suspicious; as if they were telling the person on the phone about a security breach. The victim wanted to report the incident in case anything further happened. Report is on file.

08/15 1600 block of W. Grand River for a retail fraud. The caller, who is an employee with the company, watched the subject grab a bottle of Smirnoff Vodka and when they attempted to contact the subject, the subject took off running out of the store and disappeared into the woods. Approximate cost of merchandise stolen is \$19.99. No suspect has been identified.
