Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) in Educational Leadership Program

Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) in Educational Leadership program at the University of La Verne's LaFetra College of Education.

▶ Program Overview

- A 36-semester unit, fully online doctoral program designed for PK–12 professionals seeking to advance their administrative and leadership careers.
- The program is stackable, building on prior credentials such as Preliminary Administrative Services Credential (PASC), Clear Administrative Services Credential (CASC), NISL, or a Master's in Education.
- It emphasizes leadership, applied research, and a Dissertation in Practice (DiP), with a three-day summer intensive for community and collaboration
- Two-year.

▶ Dissertation in Practice (DiP)

A four-stage applied research project that connects theory to leadership practice.

▶ Cost and Affordability

- Tuition: \$1,000 per unit x 36 units = \$36,000
- Fees: \$30 registration fee per course (12 total) = \$360
- Total estimated cost: \$36,360

▶ Admissions Requirements

- Online application.
- Bachelor's degree (minimum GPA 2.75) from an accredited institution.
- PASC, CASC, NISL, or Master's in Education.
- Official transcripts from all institutions.
- Resume and two letters of recommendation.
- PK–12 employment verification.
