RE: Request for Proposal – Central Loop at 3rd and 4th Avenue

Project No. J8920 – Memorandum 2 for Proposal Clarification Questions

Dear Proposer,

The City is issuing this memorandum to address questions received regarding our Request for Proposals for Central Loop at 3rd and 4th Avenue.

**Question 1 – Is the existing signal at 1st Street NW and 3rd Avenue NW going away?
The RFP does not talk about replacing that one.**

The intersection of 1st Street NW and 3rd Avenue NW should be evaluated as part of the traffic analysis completed for this project. Proposers should anticipate the signal being replaced as part of this project.

Question 2 – What level of Stormwater Modeling is anticipated for this project?

The storm sewer located within 3rd and 4th Avenues is either large trunklines or smaller laterals that feed into the trunklines. The large trunklines were fully analyzed as part of the work that WSB did so there is no need to look at the greater drainage area feeding the storm sewer system within the project. Therefore, it is reasonable for the consultant to simply model or design the laterals or smaller trunkline system to feed into the larger trunkline system.
