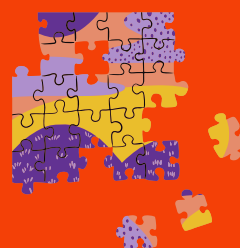

In-N-Out's Cover to Cover Club program is back for kids aged 4-12 years old! Visit the Library to learn more.

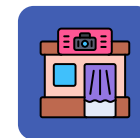


Banned Books Week:
