Subject: Town Board Referral – Sewage Pump Station Rehabilitation Project
Proposed rehabilitation of five (5) existing pump stations owned by the Town of Yorktown.

The Conservation Board reviewed the above referenced subject at their meeting held on Wednesday, September 16, 2026. Dan Ciarcia, Town Engineer, was present to explain the proposed project. Five existing pump stations are proposed for rehabilitation that includes the Hanover East Pump Station at Wellington & Kensington Court; Mohansic Pump Station at Crompond Road; Saddle Ridge Pump Station at Saddle Ridge & Salem Road; Farmwalk Pump Station at Farmwalk Road; and Crystal Lake Pump Station at Granite Springs & Sunrise Street. The proposed project will be funded by a capital improvement grant. Mr. Ciarcia went through each site and the associated work. He informed the Board this submission is to get the funding process started and that the plans and documentation need further development per site. The Conservation Board is in support of the rehabilitation of the pumping stations and look forward to reviewing the site specific plans and supporting documentation as they are further developed.
